

# Alumni Class Table FAQs

## What is our commitment as a Class Table?

Each Alumni Class is welcome to host a Class Table as a central meeting and reuniting space for your classmates at the CB Extravaganza! Alumni from Christian Brothers, Bishop Manogue, Bishop Armstrong, and Loretto are all welcome. Classes may staff their table with **four** alumni who will serve a drink or food item at your table.

We also hope that you will help us spread the excitement about the Extravaganza through your own social circles, including social media! Visit us on Instagram @cbextravaganza and repost/reshare!

## Where do we get the drink or food item?

Most classes supply their own food or drink (or both). Classes have served large-batched margaritas and Mai Tais, wine from family estate wineries, food from alumni businesses or friends, and more. Batched cocktails are often an easy and cost-effective donation toward the success of the Extravaganza! If your class is not interested in sourcing your own food or drink item, we will have donated product that needs to be served by volunteers. This will be designated to class tables on a first-to-sign-up basis.

## What are the Extravaganza hours?

The event runs 6:00-10:00, with exclusive early access in the Jack Witry Field House for about 450 VIP guests from 6:00-7:00, general admission for 1,500+ starting at 7:00, and a main stage live music performance at 7:30.

Set up can begin as early as 2:00, if needed. You will need to supervise your table once set up. Your table will also need to be cleared of your products and decorations by the end of the night.

## Can we have more than four alumni staff our table?

To be fair to all alumni and paid guests and to allow for necessary space, we do not allow more than four alumni to staff each table. ## Can I bring decorations, tents, and cooking or service equipment?

Space is limited as the event is fully enclosed on campus. We welcome you to decorate your table – bring on the nostalgia!

We do have access to power outlets throughout the venue, but it is limited. Small equipment like electric coolers and food warmers can likely be accommodated, especially if you communicate your needs early. Larger cooking and service equipment including grills, trailers, and trucks will require further conversation. Please reach out to discuss!
